Levi Lynch is 5yrs old (DOB 6/21/16) and lives in Calcutta, OH. He lives with his mom, dad, his sister Penelope and cousin Nick. He loves fishing, dinosaurs and cars. In February 2022 he developed a cough that progressively worsened in a short period of time which prompted a phone call to his doctor and visit. The doctor asked he be taken to get a chest X-ray for possible pneumonia. His parents received a phone call about an hour later asking him to be taken to Akron Children's ER for a CT scan. His parents took him and they repeated a chest X-ray and labs were done that showed a mass in his left lung. He was then transported by ambulance to Akron Children's in Akron where he was a direct admit to the oncology unit. The next day on February 9th Levi was diagnosed with T-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. Levi is getting aggressive chemotherapy currently. He is looking at a 3year total treatment plan.
